Before turning over the property, Miss Ima, a great collector and decorative arts lover, furnished the home to reflect her father's love of history and her own admiration for George Washington and other early Americans.

1st VP/Programs—Lin Fish "America's Music" to kick off new FAN year

You're sure to tap a toe and perhaps hum along when the Jubilee Banjo Band kicks off the new FAN year at our September 4 meeting. Why, you might even find yourself singing along or swinging along with the upbeat music for which the band is famous.

About 15 people gathered in 1983 to learn the fundamentals of the four-string tenor banjo in a beginner's class taught by well-known banjo player Buddy Griffin. The Jubilee Banjo Band was born soon after, growing in size and sophistication until, in 1987, it was staging full-scale variety shows on a big stage – all built around the banjo.

The Jubilee Banjo Band of Houston was inducted into the National Four-String Banjo Hall of Fame in 2002 for its "Promotion of the Banjo." It was the first band to be so honored, as all other inductees into have been individual performers.

Don't miss this live performance of ragtime and jazz music by enthusiastic performers playing America's only native instrument.
