# FAN's November program offers clues to your ancestors

Who lurks, hidden, in YOUR family tree? A ne'er do well? A clergyman? A famous actress or author? Learn a few tips and tricks for checking out your ancestors at FAN's November 7 General Meeting. Take a peek and see why so many people find genealogy research to be a fun and fulfilling hobby.

Michael and Tracey Walker, volunteers and Directors of the Klein Family History Center, will review with us the many resources the Center offers – for free -- to area residents. The Center is well-stocked with computers, microfiche and microfilm readers, historical maps and access to a wide range of genealogy and history-related Web sites. The Center's resources are available to all.

Some three dozen volunteers, each with unique talents for helping others, are available to assist with searches. Their skills can help a visitor make one exciting discovery after another, leading to solving one mystery and opening the door to another. "Where did I come from? Who were my ancestors? How far back into history could I explore?" Answers to those questions may be found right in our community ... at the Klein Family History Center!

The Center is an extension of the Salt Lake City Family History Library and is offered as a free public service, so there is no proselytizing of visitors.

After his retirement from the U.S. Coast Guard, the Walkers moved to the Klein area to be near one of their four children and two grandchildren. He volunteers in special needs classrooms and on the PTO at Mittelstadt Elementary and at his church.
