MCWC provides temporary housing, clothing, food, and legal issue assistance for women in Montgomery County and surrounding areas assistance when they need it the most. They have a 24-hour crisis hotline, emergency shelter, outreach, counseling, education, and transitional housing, and provide advocacy and accompaniment during or following a crisis.
